

# Breakout Room Task Sheet Climate Equity Accelerator – Session 1

Local Health Jurisdiction:

#### 1. Introduce or re-introduce yourselves (3 minutes) if you don't already

know each other

# 2. Draft your 2054 headline in Padlet (7 minutes)

Imagine your climate equity strategies, collaborations, and innovations were a success. Craft a headline for 30 years from now that reflects an equitable climate future. This is intended to be a brief visioning exercise, so try not to get caught up in making it perfect.

# 3. Assign team members to the first assignment for the Accelerator (5 minutes)

As we described earlier in this meeting, the Accelerator model is built on collaborative, focused efforts to advance your climate equity work locally and regionally.

An essential first step in this is understanding the context and system in which you are already or intend to start working. This baseline premise, has informed the development of our first tool, which is phase 1 of your climate equity ecosystem map, which will guide you and your teams in the process of learning and understanding more about existing aligned efforts in your jurisdiction.

The tool will guide you through a review of **3 domains – internal, external agencies, and local CBOs** (1-2 people per domain depending on the size of your team, if you have a small team, you get to assign the Alliance to one of the domains). **During our next session, you will be grouped by domain to share what you found and examine gaps and commonalities across your jurisdictions.**
